
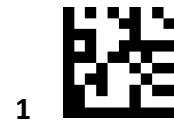


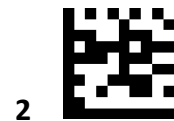
- A. Start the Bluetooth pairing process on your phone/tablet/PC (“device”).




- B.  Unlink (wait). This will also stop a constant Pin prompt on device.



- C.  Variable PIN Code (wait)



- D.  Link to PC in HID (wait)



- E. The device should show the scanner’s model + serial number. Tap or click to pair.

- F. The device gives a Pin (4, 6, or 8 digits).



- G. From the list of numeric barcodes at right, scan each digit of the Pin.

★ Don’t forget to come back to Step H. ★



For example, if your Pin is 1549, you would scan 1, then 5, then 4, then 9.

- H.  Exit Variable PIN Code




- I. The scanner should now pair.



- J. Test: Launch an application that accepts text input (e.g. Notepad or MS Word), then scan a data barcode. That data should show in your application.



- K. If you have trouble, try scanning

-  Reset Default Settings (wait) then go back to Step A.
